Elizabeth Eakins started small five years ago, and bookkeeping tasks were easily accomplished by a woman working part-time at home. But the business grew quickly. Soon it became necessary to hire both an accountant and a controller.

application. Billing and invoicing would still be performed in existing products. Then data would be extracted using a custom-written interface for delivery into a Microsoft SQL Server database.
